The Suffolk Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. will award <u>three</u> \$1,000 scholarships. African American female seniors in Suffolk Public Schools who will attend an accredited college or university during the 2021-2022 school year are eligible to apply.

The additional scholarships will also be awarded:

- \$250.00 **A Laurie Ann Hall Memorial Scholarship** (A Suffolk Public Schools African American female student currently in the 12th grade.)
- \$500.00 The Fortitude Scholarship in Honor of Miché Alston (A Suffolk Public Schools African American female student currently in the 12th grade.)
- \$200.00 **A Lillian M. Jones Memorial Scholarship** (An African American male or female Suffolk resident graduating from a Christian, Private or Public School.)
- \$500.00 So Drive Now Motors LLC Business Management Scholarship (An African American male in the 12th grade currently enrolled at Nansemond River High School, planning to attend an HBCU and major in Business.)
- \$500.00 **A Hattie P. West Memorial Scholarship** (A Suffolk Public Schools African American female or male student currently in the 12th grade.)
- \$1,000.00 S Florine Donald Memorial Scholarship (A Suffolk Public Schools female student currently in the 12th grade.)
- \$1,000.00 S Doretha S. Milteer Scholarship (3 African American female students, planning a career in education or the STEM fields, who demonstrate a high degree of scholarship, leadership, and community service. Applicants must have a 3.0 or higher grade-point average on a 4.0 scale.)
- \$500.00 **A The Lady of Lakeland Scholarship** (A Female student from Lakeland High School planning to attend an HBCU with demonstrated leadership and community service. Student with a 3.0 or higher grade-point average on a 4.0 scale.)
- \$500.00 Sermelle T. Byrd Scholarship (A Suffolk Public Schools African American female student currently in the 12th grade.)
- \$500.00 S Florence B. Bowser Book Scholarship (A Suffolk Public Schools African American female with a 3.0 GPA. Must be planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college in Virginia to major in Education.)

All scholarship awards will be given directly to the recipients. Scholarship recipients will be recognized at the Suffolk Alumnae Chapter's annual May Week Celebration (location and date to be determined).

Please, make certain that your **completed** application includes necessary information that will allow the Chapter's Scholarship Committee to make the selection. **All** applications **must** adhere to the following guidelines and criteria unless otherwise stated:

- A 2.75 Grade Point Average on a 4.0 scale.
- **Completed** application packet which includes the following:



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- o Completed application in blue or black ink
- Typed 500-700 word essay stating why you should be the recipient of this scholarship. The
 essay should address the following: community service, extracurricular activities, and any
 other information that you feel would qualify you for this scholarship.
- Official transcript (can be emailed)
- o Two letters of recommendations (can be emailed)
 - one from a guidance counselor or teacher
 - one from a non-related adult
- o Resume (email with application and essay)
- o Copy of college or university letter of acceptance or proof of application submission
