The Suffolk Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. will award three \$1,500 scholarships. Female seniors in Suffolk Public Schools who will attend an accredited college or university during the 2022-2023 school year are eligible to apply.

Additionally, the following scholarships will also be awarded:

- \$200.00 - **Athalia Joyner Richards Memorial Scholarship** (A female or male student attending an HBCU (Virginia State University or Howard University preferred) majoring in business, education, or Science; must show proof of 2.5 GPA for the second semester for the 2nd \$100.00)
- \$1,000.00 - **Doretha S. Milteer Scholarship** (1 African American female students, planning careers in education or the STEM fields, who demonstrate a high degree of scholarship, leadership, and community service. Applicants must have a 3.0 or higher grade-point average on a 4.0 scale.)
- \$500.00 – **Florence Bowser Memorial Book Scholarship** (2 female students attending a college in Virginia. Applicant must have a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.)
- \$500.00 - **The Lady of Lakeland Scholarship** (A female student from Lakeland High School planning to attend an HBCU with demonstration of leadership and community service. Must have a 3.0 or higher grade-point average on a 4.0 scale.)
- \$250.00 - **Laurie Ann Hall Memorial Scholarship** (A Suffolk Public Schools female student currently in the 12th grade.)
- \$300.00 - **Lillian M. Jones Memorial Scholarship** (An African American male or female Suffolk resident graduating from a Christian, Private or Public School.)
- \$500.00 - **The Fortitude Scholarship in Honor of Miché Alston** (A Suffolk Public Schools female student currently in the 12th grade.)
- \$1,000.00 - **Vermelle T. Byrd Scholarship** (A Suffolk Public Schools female student currently in the 12th grade.)

All scholarship awards will be given directly to the recipients. Scholarship recipients will be recognized at the Suffolk Alumnae Chapter's annual May Week Celebration (location and date to be determined).

Please, make certain that your **completed** application includes the necessary information that will allow the Chapter's Scholarship Committee to make the selection. **All** applications **must** adhere to the following guidelines and criteria:

- A 2.75 Grade Point Average on a 4.0 scale.
- **Completed** application packet which includes the following:
 - Completed application in **blue or black ink**
 - Typed 500-700 word essay stating why you should be the recipient of this scholarship. The essay should address the following: community service, extracurricular activities, and any other information that you feel would qualify you for this scholarship.
 - Official transcript (*must be sealed*)
 - Two letters of recommendations (*must be sealed*)
 - one from a guidance counselor or teacher
 - one from a non-related adult
 - Resume
